1. INTRODUCTION

This Leverage Policy explains how leverage is provided by Xtream Markets Ltd ("Company"), the risks associated with leverage, and the circumstances under which leverage levels may be adjusted.

By opening and maintaining a trading account with the Company, Clients acknowledge and accept this Policy.

2. WHAT IS LEVERAGE

2.1 Leverage allows Clients to control larger market positions with a smaller amount of deposited capital.

2.2 Leverage increases market exposure and may significantly amplify both profits and losses.

2.3 Leverage should only be used by Clients who understand the associated risks.

3. MAXIMUM LEVERAGE

3.1 The Company may provide leverage of up to:

1:1000

3.2 Maximum leverage availability depends upon:

- Account Type
- Instrument Traded
- Equity Level

- Market Conditions
- Risk Assessment

3.3 The Company does not guarantee that maximum leverage will be available at all times.

4. ACCOUNT-SPECIFIC LEVERAGE

The Company may offer different leverage levels across account types.

Examples may include:

Leverage Level	Description
1:100	Standard Risk
1:200	Moderate Risk
1:500	High Risk
1:1000	Very High Risk

The Company reserves the right to determine leverage availability.

5. INSTRUMENT-SPECIFIC LEVERAGE

Different products may have different leverage limits.

Examples:

Forex Major Pairs

Up to 1:1000

Forex Minor Pairs

Up to 1:500

Gold & Silver

Up to 1:500

Indices

Up to 1:200

Commodities

Up to 1:200

Share CFDs

Up to 1:20

Cryptocurrency CFDs

Up to 1:20

Actual leverage levels may vary and are subject to change.

6. MARGIN REQUIREMENTS

Leverage directly affects required margin.

Higher leverage results in lower initial margin requirements.

However, higher leverage also increases risk exposure.

Clients are responsible for maintaining sufficient margin at all times.

7. MARGIN CALL LEVEL

The Company's standard Margin Call Level is:

60%

When account equity falls to or below 60% of required margin:

- Risk warnings may be issued;
- New positions may be restricted;
- Account exposure may be reviewed.

The Company is not obligated to provide advance warning.

8. STOP OUT LEVEL

The Company's standard Stop-Out Level is:

30%

When account equity falls to or below 30% of used margin:

The Company may automatically close positions without notice.

Stop-Out procedures are designed to limit account losses.

9. HIGH LEVERAGE RISKS

Clients acknowledge that leverage up to 1:1000 involves substantial risk.

A small market movement may result in:

- Significant profits;
- Significant losses;
- Rapid equity depletion.

High leverage is not suitable for all investors.

10. LEVERAGE REDUCTIONS

The Company may reduce leverage at any time where necessary.

Examples include:

- Major economic events;
- Elections;
- Central bank announcements;
- Market volatility;
- Liquidity shortages;
- Risk management requirements.

Such reductions may occur without prior notice.

11. WEEKEND LEVERAGE ADJUSTMENTS

The Company may reduce leverage before:

- Weekends;
- Public holidays;
- Anticipated market events.

This measure is intended to reduce risk arising from market gaps.

12. CORPORATE ACTIONS

Leverage may be adjusted where corporate actions affect underlying instruments.

Examples include:

- Stock splits;
 - Mergers;
 - Acquisitions;
 - Dividend adjustments.
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13. CRYPTOCURRENCY LEVERAGE

Cryptocurrency CFDs are highly volatile.

The Company may apply lower leverage limits to cryptocurrency products.

Leverage limits may be amended without notice.

14. EMERGENCY RISK CONTROLS

The Company reserves the right to implement emergency risk controls including:

- Reduced leverage;
- Increased margin requirements;
- Trading restrictions;
- Instrument suspension.

Such actions may be implemented immediately where necessary.

15. CLIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Clients are responsible for:

- Understanding leverage risks;
- Monitoring margin levels;
- Maintaining sufficient account equity;
- Managing trading exposure.

Failure to do so may result in significant losses.

16. NO GUARANTEE OF PROFITS

Leverage does not guarantee profitability.

The Company makes no representation regarding:

- Expected returns;
- Trading performance;
- Profitability.

Clients trade entirely at their own risk.

17. POLICY REVIEW

The Company reserves the right to amend this Policy at any time.

Updated versions shall become effective upon publication on the Company's website.
